SURVEY RESULTS SHOW HIGHER ENGAGEMENT AMONG STUDENTS AT ONLINE UNIVERSITY

WGU is an online, competency-based university whose more than 86,000 students live in all 50 states and complete their schoolwork independently and on their own schedules.

The new National Survey of Student Engagement (NSSE) found that despite working on their own outside the walls of a traditional classroom setting, WGU students feel more connected, supported, and engaged than their counterparts at more traditional outlets. The survey polled more 517,000 students from 725 institutions, both traditional and online, asking them to rate their experiences and engagement.
