Institutional Authorization

Western Governors University is authorized to provide its educational programs in Arizona. Western Governors University is approved by the Arizona State Board for Private Postsecondary Education and offers its programs under that authority.

Licensure Pathway

Candidates applying for a teaching license in Arizona do so primarily through the direct licensure pathway. Direct licensure is available when a state allows candidates to be licensed upon completion of a program that is approved in the state of Utah. Candidates apply for licensure upon WGU confirming completion of an out-of-state program. They are not required to obtain a Utah license. Those enrolled in the BA Special Education and Elementary Education (Dual Licensure) program or BA Special Education (Mild to Moderate) program will license via reciprocity. Licensing through reciprocity means that candidates must first acquire a Utah teaching license before applying for licensure in their state. Not all states require reciprocity for all programs. Complete details on licensure requirements in the state of Arizona as well as information on applying using the direct licensure or reciprocity pathways can be found in the licensure handbook.
