Institutional Authorization

Licensure Pathway

Candidates applying for a teaching license in Colorado do so through the direct licensure pathway. Direct licensure is available when a state allows candidates to be licensed upon completion of a program that is approved in the state of Utah. Candidates apply for licensure upon WGU confirming completion of an out-of-state program. They are not required to obtain a Utah license. Complete details on licensure requirements in the state of Colorado as well as information on applying using the direct licensure pathway can be found in the licensure handbook.
