Institutional Authorization

Western Governors University is authorized to provide its educational programs in Illinois through a state authorization reciprocity agreement (NC-SARA). More information about NC-SARA is available on their <u>website</u>.

Licensure Pathway

Candidates applying for a teaching license in Illinois do so primarily through the reciprocity pathway. Licensing through reciprocity means that candidates must first acquire a Utah teaching license before applying for licensure in their state. Not all states require reciprocity for all programs. Those enrolled in an advanced program will use the direct licensure pathway. Direct licensure is available when a state allows candidates to be licensed upon completion of a program that is approved in the state of Utah. Candidates apply for licensure upon WGU confirming completion of an out-of-state program. They are not required to obtain a Utah license. Complete details on licensure requirements in the state of Illinois can be found in the <u>licensure handbook</u>.

Educational Prerequisites

WGU's education preparation programs are designed to satisfy the applicable educational prerequisites for professional licensure in Illinois for the licenses listed below. However, the Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) makes all final determinations as to license eligibility in Illinois.
