Institutional Authorization

Licensure Pathway

Candidates applying for a teaching license in New Mexico do so through the direct licensure pathway. Direct licensure is available when a state allows candidates to be licensed upon completion of a program that is approved in the state of Utah. Candidates apply for licensure upon WGU confirming completion of an out-of-state program. They are not required to obtain a Utah license. Complete details on licensure requirements in the state of New Mexico as well as information on applying using the direct licensure pathway can be found in the licensure handbook.
