Institutional Authorization

Western Governors University is authorized to provide its educational programs in Oregon through a state authorization reciprocity agreement (NC-SARA). More information about NC-SARA is available on their <u>website</u>.

Licensure Pathway

Candidates applying for a teaching license in Oregon do so primarily through the reciprocity pathway. Licensing through reciprocity means that candidates must first acquire a Utah teaching license before applying for licensure in their state. Not all states require reciprocity for all programs. Those enrolled in the MA Mathematics Education, MA Science Education, and English Language Learning programs will use the direct licensure pathway. Direct licensure is available when a state allows candidates to be licensed upon completion of a program that is approved in the state of Utah. Candidates apply for licensure upon WGU confirming completion of an out-of-state program. They are not required to obtain a Utah license. Complete details on licensure requirements in the state of Oregon can be found in the <u>licensure handbook</u>.

- BS Science Education (Secondary Earth Science) Oregon does not have an Earth Science license.
- MA Science Education (Secondary Earth Science) Oregon does not have an Earth Science license.
